First thing to do:

1. Pick a country that your troop would like to represent (Troop #52326 has SWITZERLAND)

- 2. Email your choice to muggierat@verizon.net to reserve your country.
- 3. If 2 troops want the same country, the first troop that emailed me will win
- 4. Let us know an estimate number of girls that would like to participate from your troop

Each troop can plan for the following from their country:

You can even add your own touch such as having your girls dress in that countries attire. Keep in mind when planning your things for your country, each troop visiting your country might only have 6-8 minutes. Once we get an estimate on the number of troops attending, we can give you a more accurate time frame. The adults will be running the countries table and all the girls will rotate through all the countries.

- 2. If you want, an Individual picture of each girl for the passbook
- 3. Display board to show the key / important facts about their country (PAID for w/Troop #52326 FUNDS)
- 4. Sample of a food (PAID for w/Troop #52326 FUNDS)
- 5. Small craft or SWAP (PAID for w/Troop #52326 FUNDS)
- 6. Flag from your country for the opening ceremony. It can be home made to carry.
